CODE OF CONDUCT

INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS

1. Do the home work assigned to you daily.
2. Keep your note-book neat and tidy with an up- to-date index.
3. Make it a point to revise the old portion in different subjects every day by rotation.
4. Follow strictly the home study time-table.
5. Keep the school premises clean.
6. Students should observe the rules of discipline and good behavior.
7. Students are expected to interact in English only during the school hours, else after three warnings the students will be fined.
8. All the students are expected to be in their respective class rooms ten minutes before the Assembly.
9. If the student is late for the School Assembly, they will be given three warning notices after which they are liable to be sent home at the parent's own risk.
10. No child who is late will be admitted to the regular classes.
11. Minimum 85% attendance is required to appear in the annual exams.
12. No pupil is allowed to leave the classroom without the teacher's prior permission or until the class is dismissed.
13. Pupil should not leave the school campus without obtaining prior permission from the Class Teacher and Principal.
14. Any damage to the school property or bus will be charged by the student.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS:

- a) Parents are requested to refer to the school diary and check the note from the Teacher/ Principal every day.
- b) Parents are advised to keep in touch with the Teachers concerning the progress of the child with regular intervals. (Open Day)
- c) Private tuitions are not encouraged.
- d) Any change of Address and telephone number should be informed to the school office in writing immediately.
- e) Irregular attendance, habitual, negligence of students, desire inspect to teachers etc. may lead to the removal of the student from the school.
- f) Parents are informed not to send any costly electronic goods, like mobiles, i-pod, Handycams , cameras, Laptops & Jewellery etc. If any student is found carrying such goods, they will be confiscated and will not be returned.
- g) Parents must ensure that their children come to the school punctually, with clean uniform and with proper books.
- h) Parents must ensure that children come with nutritious food like leafy-vegetables, Roti, Chapati, Dal, Rice, Fruits etc. Avoid junk foods.
